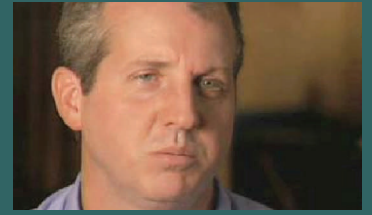


# "Bullying, Cyberbullying, and Youth Depression"
